- You will use your bookmark when your group meets to chat about the book (this is also a graded assignment!). As you read, you need to write the following entries in your bookmark, **and you need a minimum of one of each of the following entries**
  - Things you find **confusing and why they are confusing** (include page numbers)
  - Things you find **interesting and why they are interesting** (include page numbers)
  - Things that are **important and why they are important** (include page numbers)
  - Any **connections** you can make **and why** (include page numbers)
  - Any **predictions** you can make **and why you are making them**
