

## **“Early Ojibwe” Reading/Note Making Assignment**

- You need to read pages 51-65 in the Northern Lights text and make notes.
- You need to make notes as modeled in class; this is an expectation!
- **This is due on Thursday, 11/29 by the end of class**
- The note making process is as follows:
  - **Preview the Entire Assigned Section:** Look at subject headings, pictures, maps, etc. to start to familiarize yourself with the content.
  - **Read:** Completely read a section without worrying about making any notes.
  - **Re-read and Make Notes:** Re-read the section, and this time make notes at the end of each paragraph.
    - Label each section/subsection and include page numbers
    - Make notes in your own words
    - Focus on: what is important, interesting, connections you have and anything confusing
  - **Repeat:** Repeat 2 and 3 above until you have read, re-read and made notes on the entire assigned reading has been covered. Also, make sure you are labeling your notes by section as modeled in class! Your notes for this assigned reading should look like the following:
